
Abscondment

<u>Definition</u>:

When an employee abandons their job without notifying the employer

Example:

An employee who stops coming to work for weeks without notice is considered to have absconded



Annual Leave

Definition:

Paid leave granted to employees under the Employment Act 1955

Example:

A worker with 5 years' service is entitled to 16 days of annual leave per year

Apprenticeship Contract

Definition:

A formal agreement for training a worker in a trade or skill

Example:

A bakery hires a trainee under an apprenticeship contract for 2 years

Basic Salary

Definition:

The fixed wage paid to an employee before allowances or deductions

Example:

An employee's basic salary is RM2,500 before overtime and allowances




Bonus

Definition:

Extra payment given by employers, either contractual or discretionary

Example:

A company pays a one-month bonus before Hari Raya



Break Time

<u>Definition</u>:

Rest period given during working hours as per the Employment Act

Example:

Employees working more than 5 consecutive hours must get at least a 30-minute break



Code of Conduct

Definition:

A set of rules outlining expected employee behavior

Example:

A company code prohibits employees from accepting gifts from clients

Collective Agreement

Definition:

A written agreement between employer and trade union regarding employment terms

Example:

The union and management agreed on a 5% salary increment in the collective agreement

Compassionate leave

<u>Definition</u>:

Paid leave given to employees due to the death of a close family member

Example:

An employee takes 3 days of compassionate leave after the passing of a parent



Dismissal

Definition:

Termination of employment by an employer due to misconduct or poor performance

Example:

An employee caught stealing company property was dismissed



Discrimination

Definition:

Unfair treatment based on gender, race, religion, or other factors

Example:

Refusing to hire someone because of their race is workplace discrimination

Employee Provident Fund (EPF)

Definition:

A compulsory savings scheme for retirement

Example:

Employers and employees contribute monthly to the EPF

Employment Contract

Definition:

A legal agreement stating terms and conditions of employment

Example:

A written contract specifies working hours, salary, and job scope

Employment Insurance System (EIS)

<u>Definition</u>:

Provides financial aid and training to workers who lose their jobs

Example:

An employee retrenched from a factory can claim benefits from EIS

Employment Act 1955

Definition:

The main legislation governing employment in Malaysia

Example:

The Act outlines minimum leave entitlements for employees

Fixed-Term Contract

Definition:

Employment agreement for a set period

Example:

A company hires a project manager on a 12-month fixed-term contract

Forced labour

Definition:

Work performed under coercion, threat, or without consent

Example:

Confiscating workers' passports and forcing them to work is forced labour

Gratuity

Definition:

A lump sum payment given at the end of service as a reward

Example:

An employee receives gratuity upon retirement after 30 years of service



Gross Misconduct

Definition:

Serious violation of company rules justifying dismissal

Example:

Physical assault at the workplace is gross misconduct

Harassment

Definition:

Unwelcome conduct causing discomfort or intimidation

Example:

Persistent offensive jokes directed at an employee

Holiday (Public Holiday)

Definition:

Official non-working days declared by law

Example:

Employees are entitled to II paid public holidays annually

Hours of Work

Definition:

Duration an employee is required to work under contract

Example:

Employment Act 1955 highlight that an employees' hours of week for a week is 45 hours

Industrial Court

Definition:

Tribunal that resolves disputes between employers and employees

Example:

An unfair dismissal case is referred to the Industrial Court

Industrial Relations Act 1967

<u>Definition</u>:

Legislation governing employer-employee and union relations

Example:

The Act provides for collective bargaining procedures

Insubordination

Definition:

Refusal to obey lawful and reasonable orders of an employer

Example:

An employee refuses a direct order from the supervisor

Job Description

Definition:

A statement outlining duties and responsibilities of a job

Example:

The HR officer's job description includes recruitment and payroll tasks

Key Performance Indicators (KPIs)

Definition:

Measurable targets set to evaluate employee performance

Example:

A sales executive's KPI is achieving RMI00,000 monthly sales

layoff

Definition:

Temporary or permanent termination due to business downturn

Example:

A factory lays off 200 workers during a recession

leave Without Pay (Unpaid Leave)

Definition:

Leave granted without salary payment

Example:

An employee takes unpaid leave to study abroad

lockout

<u>Definition</u>:

Employer action to prevent employees from working during disputes

Example:

A company locks out workers during a strike

Maternity leave

Definition:

Paid leave granted to female employees for childbirth

Example:

A new mother is entitled to 98 days of maternity leave



Medical leave (Sick leave)

Definition:

Leave granted when certified unfit to work by a doctor

Example:

An employee takes 3 days of medical leave due to flu

Minimum Wage

<u>Definition</u>:

The lowest wage employers must legally pay employees

Example:

As of August I, 2025, Malaysia's national minimum wage has been set at RM I,700 per month for all employers, regardless of company size

Misconduct

<u>Definition</u>:

Improper behavior violating company rules

Example:

Habitual lateness is considered misconduct



Notice Period

Definition:

Time an employee or employer must give before termination

Example:

A contract requires one month's notice before resignation

Occupational Safety and Health Act (OSHA) 1994

Definition:

Law ensuring safety, health, and welfare at workplace

Example:

Employers must provide protective equipment under OSHA

Overtime

<u>Definition</u>:

Extra hours worked beyond normal working time

Example:

Employees are paid 1.5 times their hourly rate for overtime

Paternity Leave

Definition:

Paid leave granted to fathers after childbirth

Example:

A new father is entitled to 7 consecutive days of paternity leave

Payroll

Definition:

The total amount of wages paid by a company to its employees

Example:

The payroll department processes bi-weekly paychecks



Probation Period

Definition:

A trial period at the beginning of employment where the employee's suitability is assessed before confirmation as a permanent staff

Example:

Lina was hired as a sales executive with a 3-month probation period; her performance will determine whether she becomes a confirmed employee

Redundancy

<u>Definition</u>:

Termination due to a job position becoming unnecessary

Example:

Automation made several clerical jobs redundant

Retaliation

Definition:

Punishment of an employee for engaging in legally protected activities

Example:

After she reported unsafe working conditions, her employer's decision to demote her was deemed to be retaliation

Retirement Age

Definition:

The minimum age for compulsory retirement under law

Example:

The Minimum Retirement Age Act sets retirement at 60 years

Severance Pay

Definition:

Compensation paid to employees upon retrenchment

Example:

Retrenched employees receive severance based on years of service



Sexual Harassment

<u>Definition</u>:

Unwanted conduct of a sexual nature

Example:

Inappropriate touching in the workplace is sexual harassment

Strike

Definition:

Employees' collective refusal to work to protest conditions

Example:

Workers went on strike demanding higher wages

Suspension

Definition:

Temporary removal from work pending inquiry or disciplinary action

Example:

An employee is suspended while misconduct is investigated

Termination

Definition:

End of an employment contract by employer or employee

Example:

A worker resigns voluntarily, ending their employment


Trade Union

Definition:

Organization representing employees' rights and interests

Example:

The Malaysian Trades Union Congress (MTUC) is a national trade union body



Transfer of Employment

<u>Definition</u>:

Movement of employment rights from one employer to another

Example:

Employees are transferred when a company is sold

Unfair Dismissal

Definition:

Termination without just cause or excuse

Example:

Dismissing an employee for joining a union is unfair dismissal

Vesting Period

Definition:

The time an employee must serve before gaining rights to benefits

Example:

An employee becomes entitled to company shares after 3 years of service

Whistleblower Protection Act 2010

Definition:

Law protecting individuals who expose workplace misconduct

Example:

An employee reporting corruption is protected under the Act
